Application Procedure

To apply for a visitor visa to study Chinese in Taiwan, please submit the above documents and pay the visa fee at an overseas mission of the Republic of China (Taiwan).

Notices:

- 1. As a sovereign nation, the R.O.C. (Taiwan) has the right to refuse to grant visas without any explanation. The visa application fee is nonrefundable even if a visa is not granted.
- 2. With regard to foreign passport holders from certain countries, R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas missions may decide not to accept applications for visitor visas for studying Chinese. Please refer to the <u>Procedures for Nationals of the Designated Countries Applying for Visitor Visas to the Republic of China (R.O.C.)</u>.
- 3. Those who enter Taiwan under a visa-exemption program, with a landing visa, or with a visitor visa for purposes other than studying Chinese, as well as those who already reside in Taiwan for other purposes, may not convert their visas to ones for the purpose of studying Chinese in Taiwan.
- 4. Applicants who have studied Chinese for four months in Taiwan and plan to extend their enrollment for another three months or longer may apply for an alien resident certificate at the National Immigration Agency.
- 5. Original documents will be returned after visa applications have been processed. Applicants who cannot provide updated/additional documents within two weeks of a related request being made will not be issued a visa, and their application fees will not be returned.
- 6. Please refer to <u>Standard Fees for Republic of China (Taiwan) Visas in Foreign Passports (pdf file)</u>.
- 7. A certificate of admission by an accredited language center does not guarantee visa issuance. The obtainment of a visa does not guarantee entry into the country.
